**1. Citation and Commencement**

1.1 These Rules may be cited as the Summary Courts (Appeals  
Against Fixed Penalty Notices Issued Under The Public Health  
Regulations) Rules, 2021.

1.2 These Rules shall come into force on 3rd December, 2021.

**2. Interpretation**

2.1 In these Rules:

“Ordinance” means the Public Health Ordinance Chapter 12  
No. 4;

“Regulations” means the Public Health [2019 Novel  
Coronavirus (2019-nCoV)] Regulations made pursuant  
to section 105 of the Public Health Ordinance Ch. 12  
No. 4, as amended from time to time.

**3. When these Rules apply**

3.1 These Rules, unless otherwise provided, shall apply in all  
appeals against fixed penalty notices issued under sections 105, 105A, 105B  
and 105C of the Ordinance and the Regulations.

**4. Time for filing an appeal**

4.1 An appeal against a fixed penalty notice must be filed within  
twenty-eight (28) days from the date payment is due under the fixed  
penalty notice issued to the person alleged to be in breach.

### **5. Processing Fees**

5.1 There shall be charged a non-refundable processing fee in respect of each online transaction associated with the payment and refund of any fixed penalty notice fine.
