Made by the Rules Committee under section 78 of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act and subject to negative resolution of Parliament

THE CIVIL PROCEEDINGS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2020

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Civil Proceedings (Amendment) Citation Rules, 2020.
- 2. In these Rules, "the Rules" means the Civil Proceedings Rules, Interpretation 1998.
- 3. Part 2 of the Rules is amended in Rule 2.3 in the definition of Part 2 "filing" by inserting after the word "transmission" the words ", by any amended other electronic means".
- 4. Part 6 of the Rules is amended in Rule 6.2(d) by deleting the Part 6 words "if permitted by a relevant practice direction".
- 5. Part 67 of the Rules is amended in Rule 67.15 by inserting after Part 67 sub-rule (4), the following sub-rule:
 - "(5) Notwithstanding Rule 67.15(1), the fees specified in Appendix D shall not be taken in respect of filings by electronic means until 31st July, 2020 or such other date that the Chief Justice may direct by Practice Direction.".
 - 6. Part 79 of the Rules is amended in Rule 79.3—

Part 79 amended

- (a) in the heading, by inserting after the words "Days on which" the words "the physical";
- (b) by renumbering Rule 79.3 as 79.3(1);
- (c) in the renumbered sub-rule (1), in the chapeau, by inserting after the word "The" the word "physical"; and

(*d*) by inserting after sub-rule (1), the following new sub-rule:

"(2) Notwithstanding sub-rule (1), a document may be filed by electronic means at any time in accordance with such Practice Direction that may be issued by the Chief Justice."
